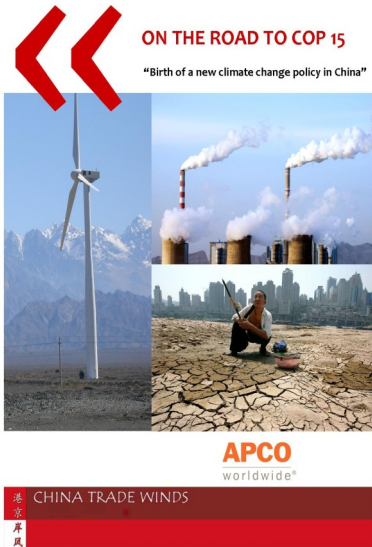


# ON THE ROAD TO COP 15

## “Birth of a new climate change policy in China”



Next December, the global warming conference in Copenhagen will have the difficult task of admitting China into an agreement which will replace the Kyoto Protocol after 2012. As the world's leading emitter of greenhouse gases for the last two years, China will have to come to Copenhagen with an acceptable offer or find itself marginalized and possibly even the subject of sanctions by the international community.
